Broadmeadows – 5th position – 7 wins, 11 losses

Eltham – 4th position – 8 wins, 10 losses

Last time they met: Broncos lost 35-51.

Finals:

Week 1: Won elimination v Latrobe by 7 points, 58-51.

Week 2: defeated Kilsyth in semi by 2 points, 40-38.

Week 3: defeated Altona in Prelim by 1 point, 52-51.

After a fantastic come-from-behind 1 point win against Altona, the Broncos will come up against Eltham in the U16 Victorian Championship Reserve Grand Final.
