## **REGISTRATIONS:**

Teams are registered online before each season. Maximum allowed is 10 players on your team list. You can have 5 on court and need a minimum of 4 to play. Most teams have 6-8 players.

Players must register to the team individually using the team code and link provided at time of team registrations. Unregistered players will not be able to take the court.

**SEASONS:** We run two six-month seasons per year. Summer Season runs from October to March. Winter Season runs from April to September.

## **COMPETITIONS:**

Games are played every Monday (except public holidays) from 6:40pm-9:10pm start times. Our stadium is Broadmeadows Basketball Stadium- Crn Dimboola Rd and Tanderrum Way.

We have Men's and Women's divisions on Monday and Wednesday evenings. Players may play on both nights, but cannot play for two teams on the same night.

## **COSTS:**

Team Registration: \$150 per team, per season. For affiliation and insurance.  
Game Fee- \$55 per team to be paid at game each week. For court hire, referees etc.  
Stadium Door Entry- \$2.50 for players and spectators.

Walkovers- Team giving walkover is required to pay the team sheet for both teams before their next game. If you can give advance notice, there is a discounted fine.

## **DUTIES:**

Each team is required to provide a competent scorer to operate the stadium scoring tablet or scoreboard during their game.

## UNIFORMS:

Teams need to provide their own uniforms. They must be colour-matching singlets and shorts (no pockets). Legal numbers are below.

## FINALS:

Finals are played over the final three weeks of each season in March and September. Most competitions play a top 4 or 8 team system- depending on the number of teams in your competition. Players are required to play in seven games during the season to qualify to play in finals.

Week 1: 1st V 2nd (Qualifying Final) & 3rd V 4th (Elimination Final)

Week 2: Loser Qualifying Final V Winner Elimination Final (Preliminary Final)

Week 3: Winner Qualifying Final V Winner Preliminary Final (Grand Final)

For competitions with 8+ teams, a 'reserve final' will be played for teams 5th-8th in the same format. E.g 5th V 6th and 7th V 8th in Week 1.
